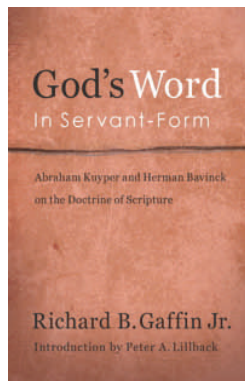

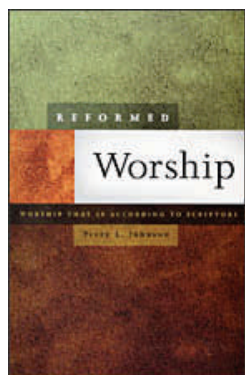

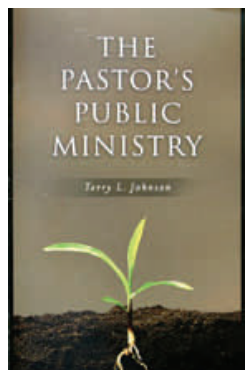


Reformed Worship: Worship That is According to Scripture

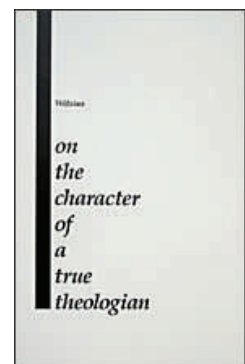


The Pastor's Public Ministry
